










# 2023 Patch Requirement



- Patches featuring our new logo were introduced in 2022
  - Optional in 2022
  - Sold at half price at \$3 per patch to reduce teams' cost of transition
- Starting in 2023, all uniforms will need to have the NEW patch
  - Cost of each patch will be \$6





















### Registration Reminders

- Special exceptions to age limit rules:
  - 19 year old junior leaders
    - 2 players (1 male and 1 female) of the CCSA-age of 19 may play on junior team
    - Must obtain Letter of Approval from supervising pastor acknowledging that they are to be mentors to future leaders
    - Assume role of either Assistant Governor/Coach
  - Junior aged players in senior division
    - Special exemption forms
    - Acknowledgement from head coach
    - Parental consent

## Update on COVID protocols

#### Stay Home & Self-Isolate if You are Sick:

Stay home until you have no fever and your symptoms are improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours if nausea/vomiting/diarrhea).

#### Follow Extra Measures:

For 10 days after the start of symptoms OR a positive COVID-19 test (whichever came first) OR for 10 days after your last close contact with a person who has symptoms or a positive COVID-19 test:



Wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings



Avoid non-essential activities where you need to take off your mask



Do not visit people or settings at higher risk
